

KANDÓ KÁLMÁN DOCTORAL SCHOOL

General information of the PhD program (stating 2016 September)

The Kandó Kálmán Doctoral School of Budapest University of Technology and Economics (BME) promotes a 2+2 year long organized doctoral program, which aims the acquiring of a PhD degree. It includes the following activities: studying of technical courses, teaching and performing scientific research. Topics of the program are available at www.doktori.hu.

Admission requirements:

- Applicants of the program shall possess a university degree in Master level preferably in the field of engineering or natural sciences or economics.
- Applicants are acceptable, if they have received their degree with a grade at least „good”.
- Applicants have to possess a language exam at least in English on B2 level.
- Applicants have to possess a comprehensive knowledge about the chosen research topic.
- Applicants should be able to present confirmed scientific results (e.g. scientific student conference presentation, publications, conferences, field trips).

Acceptance information:

- The applicants are rated based on a scoring system. All applicants are possibly acceptable, who reached at least 60 points of the maximum of 100 points after the application interview.
- Applicants, who reached the minimum threshold, but did not receive a scholarship (e.g. Stipendium Hungaricum), are possibly to be accepted in a self-financing form.
- The amount of self-financing is 4500 Euro/semester (2 semesters per year).
